This aircraft was designed and built for the USAF to be used as a short field, heavy cargo work plane. The empty weight is 22,473 lbs. and the allowable gross weight is determined by the operator; in the case of this aircraft it is 42,000 lbs. as placarded.

The aircraft has 1332 gallons of fuel carried in 4 tanks, two tanks, one in each wing and one in each engine nacelle. Each engine has a 39 gallon oil tank.

Seat belts are provided for all crew members who may be carried in the plane.

Cargo ramp and cargo door may be opened in flight allowing easy airdrop of parachutists and cargo.

This aircraft is licensed under FAR Part 8.
