

OPERATING LIMITATIONS - RESTRICTED CATEGORY

- 1. This aircraft has been certificated under the provisions of Part 21-185 for the special purpose of movie making.
- 2. The pilot of this aircraft shall operate the aircraft in a safe manner at all times during the operation of the aircraft. The pilot shall adjust the take-off weight to provide a safe margin of performance for the existing operating conditions, considering the take-off area, terrain, altitude, and temperature.
- 3. All maneuvers in connection with the motion picture making requiring the dropping of paratroopers or other articles shall be performed in such a manner to avoid personal or public injuries or damage.
- 4. All operations shall be conducted away from congested or densely populated areas, in congested air lanes, or in the vicinity of busy airports where passenger transport operations are being conducted.
- 5. Persons and cargo not directly associated with the movie making operation shall not be carried aboard this aircraft.
- 6. An approved type seat belt, installed in accordance with good aeronautical practices, shall be provided for each person carried aboard the aircraft during all flight operations. An approved type safety device shall be provided for any cameramen carried aboard the aircraft during any flight operation.
- 7. These operating limitations shall be carried in the aircraft and shall be readily accessible to the pilot during all flight operations.
- 8. All flight operations are restricted to VFR only.
- Minimum crew shall be a Type Rated Pilot and Co-pilot holding at least a Commercial Type Rating.
- 10. Crew members shall wear approved type parachutes at all times during the flight operation.
